What is 130 Women?

#130Women is a multi-disciplinary art project highlighting the contribution that women have made to the place and culture of the WA Goldfields over the last 130 years.

Why 130?

It's Kalgoorlie's 130th birthday this year, so 130 stories will be preserved in our booklet.

Whats in the Exhibition?

To compliment our booklet we have selected 13 featured women to represent the diversity and timeline of our culture. Their stories will be told through an immersive gallery experience, engaging all of your senses. We will also acknowledge all 130 Women in the exhibition.

Who's doing it?

This Goldfields Women's Health Care Centre (GWHCC) project has been led by four local artists, SJ Eeles, Linda Rae, Kelly Arcaro and Carol Thompson. We have also engaged over 80 creatives and commissioned 30+ artists with ties to the Goldfields.

What happens to all of the Artwork?

All artworks and a collection of memorabilia will be available for sale via auction, with proceeds allocated to a variety of Goldfields charities related to the featured women.

When and where is it?

The exhibition and booklet will launch during International Women's week.
